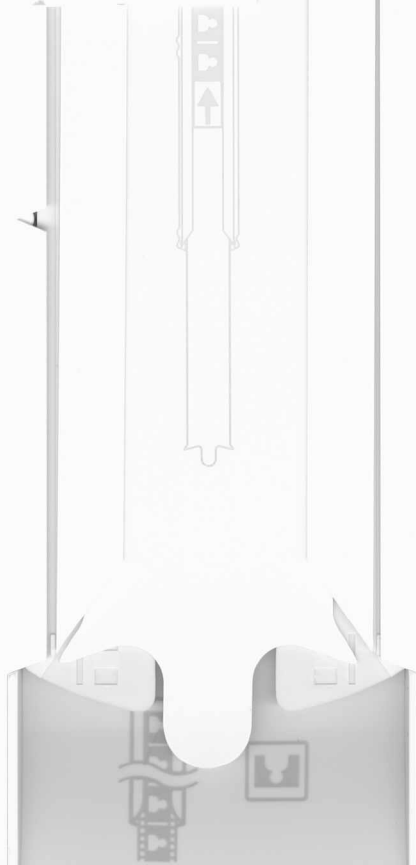

**ALUMINUM & TIN:** Cans, pie plates, foil. Please rinse thoroughly. It is not necessary to remove labels.

## **GUIDELINES FOR RECYCLING**

**NEWSPAPERS ONLY:** Cross-tied in 12" or smaller bundles.

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:** Flattened, bundled and cross-tied. Clean corrugated cardboard **ONLY**.

**MIXED PAPERS:** Cross-tied in 12" or smaller bundles. Magazines, coupons, junk mail, newspaper inserts, flyers, brochures, all envelopes, notebook paper, school paper, office paper, computer paper, stationery, fax paper, etc. (Please insert small pieces of paper into magazines).

### **TO BE COMMINGLED INTO ONE CONTAINER**

**PLASTIC:** Only plastics numbered 1 and 2. Look at the bottom of plastic container for identifying number. Please rinse thoroughly. It is not necessary to remove labels.

**GLASS:** Clear, brown and green glass jars and bottles. Please rinse thoroughly. It is not necessary to remove neck rings or labels.

**ALUMINUM & TIN:** Cans, pie plates, foil. Please rinse thoroughly. It is not necessary to remove labels.

Each customer is permitted (at the maximum) one 33 gallon barrel of commingled glass/plastic/cans and (3) 12" stacks of tied newspapers, mixed papers or cardboard. There will be a charge to your account for additional recyclables.

Southampton Village residents may only put tied newspapers at the curb. All other recyclables must be collected at our normal refuse area, for which there is a charge.

Town residents outside Southampton Village may put recyclables out to the curbside free of charge.

If your residence is missed, please call the office so that we may correct the situation. Bundled and tied paper and cardboard may be left out in inclement weather. In the Town of Southampton the following items are **NOT CONSIDERED RECYCLABLES** and should be put in with your household garbage: phone books, hardcover books, paperback books, metal caps, Styrofoam, plastic & paper bags, plastics numbered 3 through 7, waxed or plastic coated cardboard, gray cardboard (food boxes, shirt cardboard), posterboard, crystal, white glass, light bulbs, window, ceramics, mirrors.

### **ATTENTION: CUSTOMERS WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS**

Your recyclables will be picked up on **Wednesday** of recycling week. This is necessary in order to accommodate all the residents who participate in the Town's recycling program. Please have your properly prepared recyclables out Tuesday evening.
